Architects Declare is a network of architectural practices across the world committed to addressing the climate and biodiversity crisis.

Those who have joined the collective are dedicated to strengthening working practices to help create architecture and urbanism that has a more positive impact on our environment.

The signatories sign a declaration to show their dedication to creating positive change. This consists of 12 Declarations.

AEW have been a signatory to Architects Declare since 2020, publishing an annual report to be transparent about the work we are doing, to try and embed the 12 Declarations into our practice.

In 2024, AEW Architects was listed in the Regenerative Architecture Index (RAI) launched by Architecture Today and UK Architects Declare. The aim of the RAI is to benchmark practices on their regenerative policies, actions and operations instead of their profitability or size. AEW was listed as "Ones to Watch" for "Being a Good Ancestor".
